RE: Instructions for Payment of Examinations Fees/Application for Medical Card Exemption

As announced in Budget 2026, examination entry fees have been re-introduced for the 2026 state examinations. Fees will be charged at the same rate as when they were last charged in 2019. The rate of examination fees which will apply for the 2026 examinations has not been increased since 2012.

Certain candidates may be exempt from an examination fee if the candidate holds a full medical card, or is covered for all services on a parent or guardian's medical card, which is valid on or between **January 1 2026 and April 30 2026**. Candidates who believe they are eligible for such an exemption should make an application using the on-line facility. **Please note that G.P. Visit Cards are not eligible for exemption of fees.**

In order to use the online facility, you will need the information contained in this letter together with Debit/Credit Card details or Medical Card details (if applicable). Upon completion of the payment or an application for a Medical Card exemption you will receive an on line confirmation which can be printed for your records.

Payment of the fee can be made using our online facility at <https://fees.examinations.ie/> from 2pm on Thursday 19 March, 2026. Instructions on how to use the facility are set out in the User Guide on the site.

Candidates who do not have access to the online facility to make a payment or make application for medical card exemption from the examination fee, should contact Fees Section by e-mail at fees@examinations.ie.

Failure to pay examination fees may have serious consequences for candidates up to and including the withholding of the final Examination Certificate.
